ATTENDING MASS AT ST JOSEPH PARISH -

If you are sick or vulnerable, or care for someone who is, you are excused from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, and we invite you to connect with us spiritually by listening to the audio recording of our Saturday 4:00 pm Mass. The link will be emailed to you on Sunday mornings and is also available on our website: www.stjosephgrafton.org

ARRIVAL -

- The main canopy doors will be open 30 minutes before Mass.
- Facemasks are required, per Wisconsin State Mandate.
- Maximum occupancy occurs when we reach socially-distanced seating capacity.

DURING MASS -

- AV screens are in use, hymnals have been temporarily removed.
- The physical handshake of peace is temporarily suspended.
- **Communion**
 - ◇ Use personal hand sanitizer before Communion.
 - ◇ Receive Communion in the hand only.
 - ◇ Wear face mask to Communion, receive host in your hand, remove mask to consume host, then replace mask as you return to your pew.
 - ◇ Precious Blood is temporarily suspended.

DEPARTURE -

- You may exit through any of our church doors.
- We are greeting each other outside after Mass.
- Ushers will distribute bulletins at the exits.

PARISH LIFE -

- **Parish Office and Lobby** are open Monday-Thursday, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm
Friday, 8:00 am - noon
- The church is open to public prayer outside of Mass times.
- The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** is offered on Saturdays from 3:15 - 3:45 pm in the Reconciliation Chapel, following pandemic safety protocol.
- To schedule a **Baptism** please contact the Christian Formation Office at 262-375-6500, ext 120.
- **Funeral** Services and Masses must follow our weekend Mass protocol, with the assistance of a funeral home.
- **Councils and Committees** may meet virtually or on site, and **ALL** must be scheduled with the parish office. Meetings that occur on site must follow pandemic safety protocol
