## **2011 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys Basketball Tournament**

### Tournament Rules

All tournament games will be governed by the WIAA rulebook for the current season, with the exceptions and clarifications listed below.

1. Ball Size

- Games will be played with a 28.5" intermediate ball.

2. Defense

- Man-to-man defense must be played at all times during the game.

3. Pressing

- Pressing will only be allowed during the last two minutes of the game and any overtime periods. No pressing is allowed if a team is leading by ten or more points. Adequate warnings will be given to the leading team if they violate this rule. However, if after adequate warnings, a team fails to observe the rule, the officials may charge the team with a bench technical foul. The technical foul will consist of two foul shots and possession of the ball. A half-court press will be allowed at any time during the game, provided it conforms to the man-to-man defense requirement.

4. Length of Games

- Games will have 6-minute quarters and a 5-minute halftime. Overtime periods will be 3-minutes in length.

5. Game Format

- All teams will play a minimum of three games. Game scores and tournament standings will be posted. The two teams with the best record after three games will play in the boys and girls championship games. Ties will be broken by results from head-to-head match-ups and secondly by the least points allowed during the first half of all three games.

6. Other

- All other rules interpretations will be the responsibility of the tournament director and game officials.
